
The GuardianSun 4 Nov 2001 21.25 EST Washington pressed the former Soviet states of central Asia at the weekend to allow more US troops to use their bases as a bridgehead for military operations in northern <u>Afghanistan</u>. Visiting Tajikistan and Uzbekistan, which share 900 miles of frontier with Afghanistan, the US defence secretary, Donald Rumsfeld, promised tens of millions of dollars in US aid to the central Asian states in return for an expanded US military role.





FIGURE 1 Top Foreign Military Financing Recipients Since FY2001
